OUR CURRICULUM

(IGCSE) International General Certificate of Secondary Education

BISC-SL students in Grades 9 and 10 (Years 10 and 11) pursue the IGCSE, a rigorous curriculum that provides a strong foundation in core subjects. It emphasizes understanding and application of knowledge over rote memorization, fostering deeper learning and a better grasp of subjects.

Our students develop critical thinking, problem-solving, and independent research skills while choosing from a wide range of subjects, enabling them to tailor their education to their interests and career aspirations.

The IGCSE also encourages participation in extracurricular activities, promoting a well-rounded education that develops social, leadership, and teamwork skills. These advantages make the IGCSE an excellent choice for students seeking a strong academic background with international opportunities.

Course options:

Compulsory Courses: Math, English, Biology, Chemistry, U.S. History, Physical Education, and Entrepreneurship for Social Impact

Social Studies: Geography, History, Psychology

Performing Arts: Dance, Drama, Music

World Language: French, German, Mandarin, Spanish

Elective 1: Art & Design, Computer Science, Spanish (2nd Language)

Elective 2: Art & Design, Film, Engineering and Design, Sports Science

(IB) International Baccalaureate

The IB Diploma Programme at BISC-SL offers students in Grades 11 and 12 (Years 12 and 13) a dynamic and challenging education designed to foster international mindedness and intercultural understanding. Course Options:

IB Core Requirements: Extended Essay; Theory of Knowledge; Creativity, Action & Service

Group 1: Literature: English; English Language and Literature; English Literature and Performance

Group 2: Language Acquisition: French, German, Mandarin, Spanish

Group 3: Individuals & Societies, Geography, History, Psychology, Global Politics, Environmental Systems and Societies

Group 4: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Design Technology, Physics, Sports Exercise and Health Science

Mathematics: Analysis and Approaches, Application and Interpretation

Group 6: Biology, Design Technology, Film, Global Politics, Music, Theatre Studies, Visual Arts

Course Routes:

Based on their Year 10-11 performance, students in Years 12 & 13 follow one of three IB course routes:

1.) IB Diploma Students study six IB courses, three must be at Higher Level (HL) honors and three at Standard Level (SL).

2.) IB Scholar Students study six IB subjects at Standard Level honors or Higher Level. Students may choose a max of 3 HL courses.

3.) College Prep, students study a combination of 6 courses at college prep, SL or HL.
